April: Lunch will be stew & corn bread, dessert and a drink

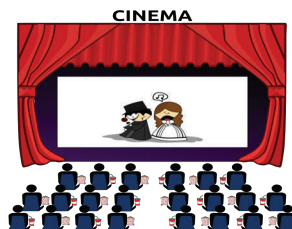
