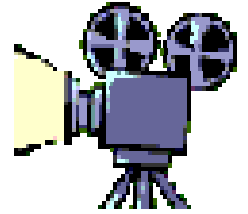




# Movie Matinee

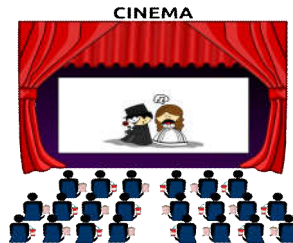
